Biography

At Lovat House Dental, Andrew provides specialist opinions and treatments in Fixed and Removable Prosthodontics including Implant Dentistry, the full range of Specialist Periodontal care and Specialist Restorative Dentistry.

Andrew is keen to save and use natural teeth where possible in dental reconstructions. He also uses minimally invasive modern techniques where possible to reduce morbidity and risks for patients whether that be in relation to modern bone grafting techniques for dental implants, regenerative surgery around periodontally involved teeth, or advanced adhesive dentistry techniques to manage aesthetic challenges and tooth wear.

For several years, Andrew has been providing Specialist private dentistry in a state of the art specialist referral centre in Newmarket, Suffolk. He continues to be the lead Restorative Consultant for improving dental aesthetics and function for patients affected by Cleft Lip and Palate for the East of England Cleft Network working closely with Maxillofacial and Orthodontic colleagues. He is lead consultant for the dental implant programme at Addenbrooke's, Cambridge University Hospital and was previously an Honorary Visiting Consultant in Restorative Dentistry at the University of Bristol Dental Hospital.

He is a unit lead for the University of Bristol MSc Programme in Dental Implantology. Andrew has extensive teaching experience involving specialist trainees as well as general dental practitioners.

During his 5 year full time Restorative Specialist Training program he attained a University of Bristol MSc in Dental Implantology with Distinction and experience in university departments in Bristol, Birmingham and London. International experience was gained at the University of Leuven, Belgium, Malmö University, Sweden and in Holland Bloorview Hospital/ITI scholarship centre in Toronto, Canada.

Andrew has supplemented his implantology and periodontology skills with further advanced periodontal regeneration microsurgery training with world leaders Cortellini and Tonetti in Florence. He also trained at the Urban Regeneration Institute for advanced bone and soft tissue regeneration for implants.

Referral Policy

We aim to work in partnership with you in managing your patient. If you wish to be involved in certain aspects of care, then please do let us know.

We will contact you and request your approval if a patient requests, or we think it is necessary to provide care beyond the scope of your initial referral.

We will write to you to acknowledge receipt of your referral.

We are always happy to meet dental colleagues in person or arrange a telephone call if you have a query or wish for further information - Please contact our reception to arrange this.

- We will contact the patient as soon as possible to arrange booking a convenient appointment.
 - Before the patient's first appointment, we will send them information including their appointment details and fee, a map of our location and a biography of the clinician they will be seeing.
 - At the appointment we will discuss all treatment options with the patient and try to ensure they understand these thoroughly before decisions on treatment are made.
 - Following their consultation, we can provide a bespoke report for the patient outlining their options regarding future treatment and estimated costs. We will also send a letter to you as the referring clinician regarding the clinical findings/diagnoses and treatment options discussed.
 - We will always encourage your patients to continue receiving their general and preventative/hygiene dental treatment from your practice.
 - Once the specialist care is completed, we will write to you detailing the treatment carried out and any recommended follow up procedures or maintenance care necessary.

Example Fees

Initial consultation of up to one hour including necessary intra-oral radiographs and written report back to the referring dentist and patient as required: Fixed Fee £148.

Course of Specialist Non-Surgical Periodontal Therapy over a minimum of three visits: from £800.

Specialist Periodontal Surgery from £750.

Management of toothwear from £325 per tooth.

Dental Implant placement from £1650

Dental Implant screw retained crown from £1250

Specialist care fees are based on time required, case complexity and associated laboratory fees.
